5Star Progression



As ONE OF the UK's oldest grassroots football clubs, Continental Star FC, has kicked its way through the game's perceived glass ceiling after five of its coaches have been snapped up by professional clubs. Star, which celebrates its 40th anniversary later this year, has just seen three of its coaches invited to join West Bromwich Albion, while another two are going to Wolverhampton Wanderers.

It is fantastic news for Continental's general manager Lincoln Moses, one of the West Midlands' most respected figures in grassroots football. And he is delighted because even though five of his top coaches will be teaching at other clubs, they will still be able to use their skills at Continental – being able to work at both. "While I'm thrilled that other clubs want them, I'm an even happier man that Continental will not be losing them," said St Kitts-born Moses, who chairs the Race Equality Advisory Group (REAG). "At grassroots football everyone is always aware of the glass ceiling that can be a barrier in the game, but these five appointments are proof that we can break through this."

Delton Francis is off to West Brom after being head hunted from Birmingham City. He will continue to run the club's first team. Francis will be joined by fellow coach Aaron Garvey, the winner of a bursary set up by Brendon Batson, a former West Brom defender. Garvey has already made a name for himself by coaching Continental's Under-18's to victory in the County FA Youth Cup final last season, being the first inner-city club to scoop this honour.

Jason Sylvester, Continental's Under 14's coach, is also West Brom-bound as an Under 12's coach. While Wolves have snapped up Wesley Hughes, Continental's reserve team assistant manager and Darren Wright, a former Cheltenham and Wrexham player who made



Moses, who has been elected to anti-racism campaign Kick It Out's guidance advisory group, is a three-time nominee for the annual Voice-backed Black List Awards, added: "This is all about passing the baton, but it's also about knowing how to profile ourselves in a certain way in order to be part of the system."

Continental Star began as an inner-city club and is now a social enterprise, offering football teams from under-eighteens to over 35's, and women's teams. It also provides after school homework clubs, supports disadvantaged young people and offers advice to the unemployed and lone parents.

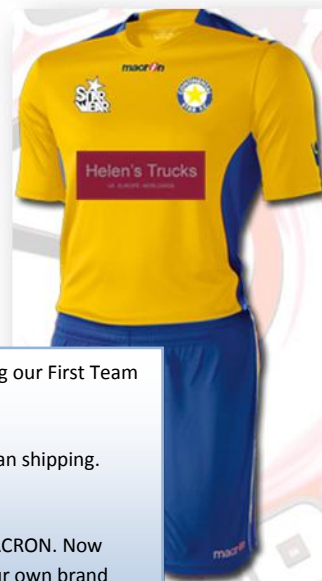
